

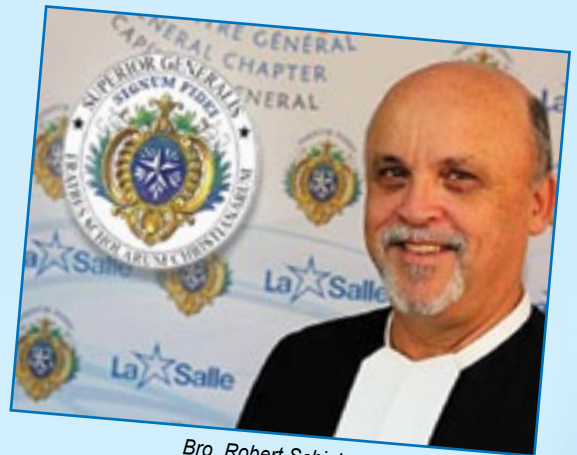

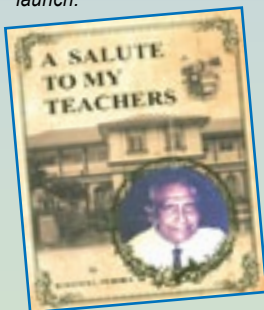

Among the dinner team seated in the front were co-chairman Huzefa Iskandar, speaker-in-chief Adhika Razak, and Executive President of Yayasan.

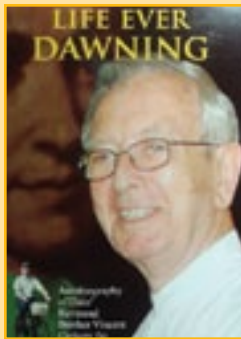
The guest of honour was Education Minister Huzefa Iskandar.
